Earn your MA in Germany – at your own pace! Designed for leaders and decision makers serving around the world

Are you challenged in your cross-cultural context to reflect on your **understanding and practice of leadership**? This program offers you an opportunity to do just that. It enables you to support local leaders and churches in the development of their own structures and leadership principles.

In English!

- Courses fully online or with short on-campus-periods (5 days/course)

Admissions Requirements:

- Accredited Bachelor's degree
- Minimum of 15 credit hours Bible/Theology/History
- At least one year of related ministry experience

Length:

- 33 credit hours
- 2,5 – 10 years, minimum 1 course/year

Tuition:

Per course (3 credit hours): 630,- €

Pay as you go!

Room and board available.

Start:

Ideally January with required course "Mission & Methods of Theology" (fully online), or any other on-campus-period for English courses. Application to be submitted two months prior to the first course.

CAS in Intercultural Leadership

Not enough time for a complete degree program? How about a Certificate of Advanced Studies on the graduate level? With short on-campus periods (five days/course) or fully online?

Lifelong learning opportunities allow you to continuously acquire skills for your area of ministry. Certificates of Advanced Studies (CAS) serve exactly this purpose. This CAS consists of **four courses on the graduate level** (12 credit hours) and is therefore ideally suited to help you:

- master current challenges through specialized training.
- deepen your knowledge and expand your skills without having to commit to a complete degree program.
- gain a qualified introduction to a topic while opening up options for further studies.

Completed CAS courses can be applied towards a MA degree or transferred to other universities.

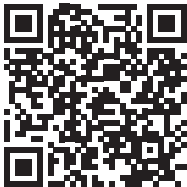
